Taking responsibility for the social cues that students give to each other take time and maturity to interpret. The adults in their lives can help by giving labels to your student about both individual and friends' body language and facial expressions. As development of friendships continues to grow and change, encourage your student to remember, "A friend loves at all times." (Proverbs 17:17).
